Workshop Review Process

We know the workshop review process has been confusing at times, so we appreciate your diligence in getting your workshops approved. The current process is to prioritize those workshops that have been scheduled. You will submit your content outline to the RTC who scheduled your workshop. If it was scheduled through a county agency and they are using OCWTP funds, then you submit your material to the RTC that serves that county.

Once submitted, the RTC will review the outline using a standardized process. It is likely they will contact you more than once during the review process to get additional information. They will submit your materials to IHS for a second review and to be entered into E-Track.

- Go to www.ibackup.com and enter the user name and password (all lower case letters) at the top of the homepage.
 - user name: **ocwtptrainers**
 - password: **please contact Debra if you need the password**
- To see what is in a folder, simply click on it.
- To download files and folders, click on "upload/download folder" on the toolbar across the top of the screen.
- In the new window, click the button in the middle that says "Login to Webfolders."
- Re-enter the username and password (might have to do this step twice).
- You will then see a new window that works like "My Computer" does:
 - highlight files and folders you wish to copy
 - right click and select "copy"
 - navigate to where you want to put them on your local computer (using the address bar at the top of the window)
 - right click and hit "paste"
