AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER STRATEGIES IN ACTION: TODDLER AND PRESCHOOL AGE

1. Go to <https://autismcertificationcenter.org/> and select “Log In” from the top right menu.
2. Enter the email and password you selected when you created your account for the “Many Faces of Autism” prerequisite course.
3. Select “Start Course” under “Toddler and Preschool Age”
4. This course is comprised of nine modules.
5. You must complete each module and pass the comprehensive assessment by 80% to receive a certificate from the Autism Certification Center.
6. In order to see continuing education certificates on your certificate, you must first go to your profile page on the ACC site and add the crediting organizations of your choice to your profile. You will be asked to provide a valid license/ID number in order to complete this step. Once you've download your certificate(s) they'll appear on the ACC dashboard under the Continuing Educations tab. You'll notice approval numbers on the upper right hand corner of your certificates (above the course description).
7. Forward that certificate of completion to e-track@ihs-trainet.com to have training credit reflected in your E-Track training transcript. The course will

be reflected in your transcript as OCWTP hours only and licensure hours will be added as a separate supplemental history line item—as licensure hours were provided by the Autism Certification Center rather than the OCWTP).
